Users Guide for Running and Walking Events

The Venue: Physical address: 840 Mauldin Road, Greenville, SC 29607

The Courses: 1 Mile, 5k (3.1 miles), 6k (3.7 Miles), 8k (4.97 miles), 10k (6.2 miles).

All Course are currently being updated for 2016.

Course maps are available upon request. All course marking will be done by the Renter. **Marking will be done with approved materials only. No paint is to be used on Course.** (Course marking can be done by Greenville County PRT Staff for an additional fee.) The course will be returned to its original condition at the conclusion of the race. Clean up fee will be added if not completed. Please respect the natural environment of the parks. Holding events in the nature park is a privilege that requires Leave No Trace stewardship. The actions of event managers and participants directly affect the future use of these facilities.

On each course map Greenville County PRT has recommended water stops. The renter may choose to use their own locations however, it is understood that **ALL** materials, which includes all cups and trash, will be picked up by Renter at the conclusion of the race. The parks are open to the public during all events and race volunteers, rest stops, and activities shall not impede access to the park facilities.

The renter will make sure that a course sweep is assigned. This is to guarantee that no participant is left on the course unattended.

Race Times: All races will begin no later than 8:30 am.

Shelter: Shelter has electrical power and seating for 185 people. It is the responsibility of the Renter to police the shelter and deposit all used trash bags into the dumpster on-site. A clean up fee will be added to final invoice if this is not done.

Restrooms: Men's and Women's restrooms that can handle up to 185 racers are located next to shelter. If additional restrooms are required the stadium can be opened.

Inclement Weather: Greenville County PRT reserves the right to cancel all events as a result of inclement weather. The Renter and Greenville Rec Staff will communicate on all weather related issues.

Medical Support: Belmont Fire Department will respond to any emergency that is in Lake Conestee Nature Park (Trails that are across the Reedy River). City of Greenville will respond to all calls inside Conestee Park (Shelter and parking lot).

Chief Seager at Belmont Fire Department (chief@belmontfiredepartment.com) is our contact. Greenville County PRT must receive notice that Belmont Fire Department has been contacted. City of Greenville Fire Department will receive notification as a result of your permit.

On site medical personnel is not required but is **STORNGLY** encouraged.

Insurance: Greenville County PRT must receive proof that a policy of at least \$1,000,000 has been purchased for the event. This Certificate of Insurance must be received at least 14 days prior to the event date. Greenville County will need to listed as an additional insure.

The Fees: Fees are determined by the number of **REGISTERED** runners. This number will be collected after the event.

\$50 deposit is required to hold date (will be deducted from final invoice)

\$150 cleaning fee (only applied if standard is not met)

\$6 per runner for venue only

City of Greenville Permit:

Renters most complete the City of Greenville permit as well. This permit must be submitted no later than 90 days prior to the event. The permit required by the City of Greenville will have additional fees. The link below can be used:
