



Rules For Boats

1. All boat passengers must have a signed waiver turned in at registration.
2. The entire boat must be made from corrugated cardboard.
3. The hull of the boat may not be wrapped in plastic, duct tape or shrink wrap.
4. Only seams and joints may be taped, not the whole boat.
5. The only adhesive that can be used is duct tape. Colored tape is allowed if the tape was manufactured in color.
6. Absolutely NO use of the following items: tar-based substances, two-part varnishes, fiberglass resin, epoxy glue, or corrugated cardboard that's bonded to any surface.
7. The boat's passenger area must not be enclosed. Each passenger must be visible while the boat is in the water.
8. Only one-sided and two-side paddles are permitted; one paddle per person. You may use your hands to paddle only after your paddle has been lost (dropped, sunk, etc.).
9. To be considered a finisher, the passengers must be **IN** the boat. You can't tow the boat to the finish line.
10. All passengers must have Coast Guard certified lifejackets on during the entire race. Jackets are available at the race.
11. Boats are not to exceed 8 feet in length and 4 feet in width.
12. All boats are subject to technical inspection for compliance with the rules. All boats must pass inspection to be eligible to enter the water. You will have a chance to fix any violations before the race.
13. You must have fun and laugh before and during the races!!!
14. Passengers must be 7 years old or older. All Corporate Division boats must have one employee in the boat.
15. Race committee reserves the right to adjust rules if deemed necessary.
