

COVID19 Operational Guidelines for Waggin at the Waterpark-2020
(September 12 at Discovery Island & September 19 at Otter Creek)

1. Limit the number of participants (dogs & humans) in each session by using the following schedule: (No more than 2 people per dog). We will not be accepting "Day Of" registrations, you MUST PRE-REGISTER.

An extra 15 minutes has been added in between sessions for cleaning/sanitizing. I will email registered participants of this time change prior to the day of the event.				

2. "Stay Back" (Practice Social Distancing) when checking in. Six-foot spacing markers will be used for all lines (including checking in and gate entry into waterpark). Staff will assist with crowd control and also make periodic announcements for reminders.
3. Posters & signs will be displayed throughout the event area to remind participants of social distancing requirements and the use of face masks is encouraged, as well as other steps such as covering your face when you sneeze or cough, using hand sanitizer or washing your hands frequently to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
4. Encourage covering any cough or sneeze with a tissue, throwing tissue away after use, or sneezing/coughing into elbow and immediately washing hands or use sanitizer. Tissues, trash receptacles and hand sanitizers will visibly be available at check in tables.
5. Commonly used surfaces such as registration tables & gate latches will be cleaned & disinfected hourly and more often if needed. The waterpark will follow the guidelines they have required all summer for restrooms.
6. No water fountains will be in use. We will encourage participants to bring their dog's own water and water bowl while waiting to enter the waterpark.
7. Concessions will be open using the [same guidelines required all summer](#).
8. Hand sanitizers will be in place at each poop station.
9. Chlorine will remain in the water – checked with Rocky Creek vet (one of the sponsors) and with Animal Care, they both agree that it will not harm the dogs.
10. No toys will be allowed (tennis balls, frisbees, etc.)
11. Encourage participants to avoid petting other participants' dogs.
