Tournament Information

We are thrilled to bring you the 10th Anniversary of the Foot Solutions Greenville County Smash presented by Devoted Health.

DATE & LOCATION

This event takes place September 17-20, 2026 at [East Riverside Park](#) (1155 S. Suber Rd, Greer, SC 29650).

SCHEDULE

Thursday, September 17: **Adaptive Unified Doubles** (5:30-8:30pm)

Friday, September 18: **Women's Doubles** (8:30am-9:30pm)

Saturday, September 19: **Mixed Doubles** (8:30am-9:30pm)

Sunday, September 20: **Men's Doubles** (8:30am-9:30pm)

AGE DIVISIONS

Adaptive Unified: 1 player with a disability, 1 able-bodied unified partner. Any gender or age combination (18+). Emphasis on **Meaningful Involvement**.

Women's: 2 female players. 18+, 45+ and 60+ age divisions.

Mixed: 1 female player, 1 male player. 18+, 45+ and 60+ age divisions.

Men's: 2 male players. 18+, 45+ and 60+ age divisions.

Teams must play at the age division of the youngest partner. Players register for an age group based on their age as of December 31, 2026. Tournament staff reserves the right to combine age divisions based on registration.

SKILL RATINGS

Adaptive Unified: Divisions will be determined after registration closes to align team skill levels based on the adaptive player.

Women's, Men's and Mixed: 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5, 5.0+

Teams must play in the skill division of the higher rated partner. Unsure of your skills rating? Refer to the Pickleball Level Self-Assessment Sheet or ask your local USAPA ambassador for an assessment of your skill level. If you are rated with DUPR, register using your current rating. Tournament staff will not rate players. Tournament staff reserves the right to combine skill ratings based on registration.

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FORMAT

When the initial schedule is posted on Friday, September 11, all registered teams are guaranteed a minimum of 5 robin games. Following round robin play, qualifying teams in each posted division advance to the medal round.

Adaptive Unified: 15-minute timed games

Women's, Men's and Mixed: 11pt round robin games, 15pt medal round games

First Tournament Division: **\$59**

Each Additional Division: **\$19**

Players may register for up to 1 division per day

REGISTRATION

- Registration runs from July 1 through August 24. Registration closes once the daily capacity has been reached or on August 24, whichever comes first.
- Registrants are required to list a partner at time of registration.
- Both partners must pay the registration fee before a team is added to the tournament schedule. Players must register within 48 hours of each other to secure their team's spot in the tournament. Failure to do so will result in an incomplete team registration, and that team will be moved to the waitlist.
- Adaptive wheelchairs can be reserved during registration for those who require one on a first-serve basis.

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SUBSTITUTE PARTNERS

After August 24, a substitute partner must be declared to tournament staff for the team to remain in the tournament. The substitute partner must be of the same skill level and age division as the person they are replacing. Failure to do so will result in the team being dropped from the schedule and wins by forfeit awarded to opposing teams. After August 24, a substitute partner will assume the registration fee paid by the original partner. Substitute partners must commit to replacing the original partner for 100% of all scheduled games. A second substitute partner is not permitted once the team's first round robin game has begun.

CANCELLATIONS

If an athlete cancels any of their registered divisions prior to August 24, a refund will be issued minus a \$15 administrative fee. No refunds will be issued after the August 24 change & cancellation deadline. Refunds will not be issued if a) you are registered for 2+ divisions and are canceling 1 division prior to August 24, b) changes are made to a player's registration after August 24 that are outside of injury, sickness, or other unforeseen emergency circumstances, or c) there is inclement weather and, as a result, a player's division is unable to be played.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

- There will be no dedicated makeup day for matches that are canceled due to inclement weather.
- Matches that are *postponed* due to weather will be rescheduled on the same day, if possible. Registrants who no-show for rescheduled matches will forfeit those matches.
